DECISION n° 383

of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways amending the Single Programming Document 2025-2027 (#4)

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR RAILWAYS,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2016/796 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2016 on the European Union Agency for Railways (hereinafter referred to as "the Agency") and repealing Regulation (EC) No 881/2004 (hereinafter called "the Regulation"), and in particular Article 51§1 (b) and 52§4 thereof,

Having regard to Decision n°360 of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways adopting the Single Programming Document 2025-2027,

Having regard to Decision n°369 of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways amending the Single Programming Document 2025-2027 (#1),

Having regard to Decision n°379 of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways amending the Single Programming Document 2025-2027 (#2),

Having regard to Decision n°382 of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways amending the Single Programming Document 2025-2027 (#3).

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:


Article 1

1. Substantial amendments of the SPD 2025-2027 procurement plan

1.1. New Procurement procedures

1.1.1 Call for expression of interest

Call for expression of Interest (CEI) to establish a list of independent experts to provide expertise in the field of vehicle authorisations	143,000€ ¹

On 7.1.2022 a framework contract was signed ERA-2021-2-OP for assisting the Agency in vehicle authorisations expertise. It expires 6.1.2026. There have been issues with it, for example: a high rotation of experts and tenderers were on occasions conflicted (having worked with applicants before), etc. In order to ensure business continuity following 6.1.2026 and to keep providing the necessary expertise in the field, a new call to outsource VA expertise is necessary. There has been a successful experience with other CEI calls. It is appropriate to start the process to put in place a pool of independent experts for VA. Given the important workload on this matter, it would be important to set up this call as soon as possible.

The ceiling is at 143 000€ and it applies per expert and for the duration of the list, maximum of 5 years.
