DECISION n° 402

amending Decision n° 359 of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways on business continuity/deputising for the Executive Director following the entry into force of ERA-ED-DEC-2416-2026 and ERA-ED-DEC-2417-2026

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR RAILWAYS,

Having regard to:

Regulation (EU) 2016/796 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2016 on the European Union Agency for Railways (hereinafter referred to as “the Agency”) and repealing Regulation (EC) No 881/2004 (hereafter referred to as “Regulation (EU) 2016/796”), and in particular Article 51(1)(f) and (h) thereof,

Decision of the Executive Director of the European Union Agency for Railways ERA-ED-DEC-2416-2026 establishing the Agency’s internal structures;

Decision of the Executive Director of the European Union Agency for Railways ERA-ED-DEC-2417-2026 on staff allocation within the Agency;

Whereas:

It would be appropriate to update the roles to perform the tasks set out in Article 1(1) MB Decision n°359 where the Executive Director, or the Acting Executive Director, is prevented from fulfilling his/her functions (e.g. indisposed, uncontactable) to reflect the Agency’s internal structures and staff allocation.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

1. Article 1(3) of MB Decision n° 359 is substituted by the following:

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3. *Where the Executive Director, or the Acting Executive Director assigned under paragraph 2, is*

prevented from fulfilling his/her functions (e.g. indisposed, uncontactable) the tasks in paragraph 1 shall be performed by:

- i. the Head of Safe Rail Department, or in their absence;*
- ii. the Head of Interoperable & Cost-Effective Rail Department, or in their absence;*
- iii. the staff member designated by the Management Board Chair. "*

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption. It will be published on the Agency website.
