DECISION nº 88

of the Administrative Board of the European Railway Agency amending the work programme 2013

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN RAILWAY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 881/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council¹ establishing a European Railway Agency (hereinafter referred to as "the Agency"), and in particular article 25 (2) c thereof;

Having regard to the ERA Work Programme 2013 adopted by the Administrative Board on 19 December 2012 by written procedure;

Whereas:

In order to clarify the procurement plan 2013 and to proceed to a number of adjustements aiming to reflect the deferred implementation of three call for tenders for studies and the estimated amount of a fourth one;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:
