

## DECISION n° 70

### of the Administrative Board of the European Railway Agency amending the work programme 2012

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN RAILWAY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 881/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>1</sup> establishing a European Railway Agency (hereinafter referred to as "the Agency"), and in particular article 25 (2) c thereof;

- 1) In order to clarify the procurement plan 2012 and to proceed to a number of adjustments aiming to reflect the performance of six call for tenders for studies and their estimated amount as well as to include two additional calls for framework contracts;
