DECISION n°71

of the Administrative Board of the European Railway Agency adopting the statement of estimates 2013

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN RAILWAY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 881/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing a European Railway Agency¹ (hereinafter referred to as "the Agency") as amended by Regulation (EC) No 1335/20082 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008², and in particular article 38(8) thereof;

Having regard to the Agency's Financial Regulation adopted on 15 July 2004, as amended on 28 October 2008, and in particular article 27.2 thereof, requiring that a statement of estimates of revenue and expenditure including an establishment plan be produced by the Administrative Board,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:
