

**DECISION n°97**  
**of the Administrative Board of the European Railway Agency adopting an amending budget  
2014**

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN RAILWAY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 881/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing a European Railway Agency<sup>1</sup> (hereinafter referred to as "the Agency"), and in particular article 38(8) thereof,

Having regard to the Agency's Financial Regulation adopted on 31 December 2013 and in particular article 34 thereof,

Whereas:

The figures in the revenues of the budget 2014 adopted by the Administrative Board on the 26 November 2013 are not aligned with the figures in the European Commission budget for the Agency.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

*Article 1*

The Agency's Budget 2014 shall be amended as follows:

The total budget is increased by €20 600 and reaches €25 715 600 (instead of €25 695 000) with a different distribution on the revenue side.
