


Annex III

Access to the meeting location

By train:

Direct train connections from Brussels, Koblenz, Liège, Paris and Strasburg.

By Roads:

CFL Coach from Saarbrücken

From Bruxelles/Namur/Arlon: E411 then E25/A6 until 'La croix de Gasperich' - Exit 'Luxembourg Gare / Hesperange' towards A3

From Liège: E25/A6 until 'La croix de Gasperich' - Exit 'Luxembourg Gare / Hesperange' towards A3

From Saarbrücken: A8/A13 until 'La croix de Bettembourg' then A3 until 'Gare de Luxembourg'

From Trier: A64/A1 until 'La croix de Gasperich' - Exit 'Luxembourg Gare / Hesperange' towards A3

By Air: Luxembourg Airport

Connections with bus 16 or bus 29 (every 5 minutes) 2 euros, around 30 minutes trip Taxi: around 15-20 minutes trip, +/- 25 euros.
