WORK EXPERIENCE in the Ministry for Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology/Ministry for Transport, Innovation and Technology (from 2006 to PRESENT) Michael Luczensky was appointed as head of the Railway Directorate in the Federal Ministry for Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology (BMK) in November 2017. His area of responsibility includes the legal and administrative agendas for the railway sector. The Railway Directorate carries out the tasks of the National Safety Authority and its scope of responsibility also includes participation in the creation and implementation of Union law and intergovernmental agreements in the field of railways, including the representation of these matters in EU bodies and other bilateral and multilateral bodies. Before his appointment as head of the Railway Directorate Michael Luczensky was the deputy Head of cabinet of the former Federal Minister Jörg Leichtfried and previously worked in various functions at the Ministry.
