# Annex

## Calculation method for the annual indexation of amounts

## Basic principles for the indexation

### 1. Legal basis for the indexation of Fees & Charges

Fees and charges payable to the Agency and the conditions of their payment are established in <u>the</u> <u>Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/764</u> as amended by <u>the Commission</u> <u>Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/1903</u>.

Article 10(1a) establishes that:

"Amounts referred to in the Annex shall be indexed by the Agency, for the first time in 2023 and once every financial year thereafter, with effect from 1 January, based on

(a) the annual update of the remuneration and pensions of the officials and other servants of the European Union and the correction coefficients applied thereto as published in the Official Journal of the European Union, in accordance with a calculation method to be agreed by the Agency's Management Board, and based on the relevant annual financial data used in the Agency's Single Programming Document and its Consolidated Annual Activity reports; and/or

(b) the inflation rate in the Union, in accordance with the method set out in point 4 of the Annex."

## 2. Cost structure of the Fees & Charges

The amounts of Fees & Charges are structured as follows<sup>1</sup>:

- a fixed fee for the use of one-stop shop (OSS) ('fixed OSS fee'),
- a fixed fee due with the submission in the OSS of applications for authorisations in conformity to a vehicle type (VA-CTT) the fixed OSS fee is included,
- an appeal fee when an appeal<sup>2</sup> is dismissed or withdrawn,
- either a fixed OSS fee **and** an hourly rate, or an hourly rate alone for all other applications submitted in the OSS and chargeable services offered by the Agency.

To perform the indexation of the amounts, it is necessary to break down the costs to distinguish the elements that need to be indexed with a reference to:

- Article 10(1a)(a) the annual update of the remuneration and pensions of the officials and other servants of the European Union and the correction coefficients applied thereto, and
- Article 10(1a)(b) the inflation rate in the Union



To that end, it is appropriate to use a cost-breakdown model<sup>3</sup> depicting the precise determination of the subamounts which compose the global amounts detailed in the Annex to the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/764 as amended by the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/1903.

#### Breakdown n.1 linked to the hourly rate of the Agency

More precisely, the percentual distribution of the sub-amounts for processing applications is as follows:



#### Breakdown n.2 linked to the fixed fee due with the submission of VA CTT applications

From the hourly cost and the cost for the use of OSS in VA CTT applications, the breakdown of the fixed fees is as follows:

#### 3. Assignment of an index to the cost-breakdown elements

Following 2., the assignment of an index depending on the nature of the cost-breakdown elements:

- Remuneration and pensions of the officials and other servants of the European Union (IRSP)<sup>4</sup>, or
- General inflation in the EU for goods and services (IGS)<sup>5</sup>, follows:

IC04- Cost related to the Board of Appeal	0.30%	IRSP

#### 4. Formulas for the indexation

Having considered points 1., 2. and 3. the formulas to be used are as follows:

4.1 Indexation of hourly rate

Hourly Rate  $_{Year n} = Hourly Rate_{Year n-1} \times [1 + IRSP_{Year n-1} \times (90.60\%) + IGS_{Year n-1} \times (9.40\%)]$ The result of the calculation shall be rounded up to next integer.

#### 4.2 Indexation of the fixed fee for the use of the one-stop shop (OSS)

Fixed Fee OSS  $_{Year n} = Fixed Fee OSS_{Year n-1} \times (1 + IGS_{Year n-1})$

4.3 Indexation of the fixed fee for authorisations in conformity to a vehicle type (VA-CTT) Fixed Fee VA - CTT  $_{Year n} = OSS cost_{Year n-1} \times (1 + IGS_{Year n-1}) + Units x Hourly Rate_{Year n}$ The result of the calculation shall be rounded up to next integer.
