

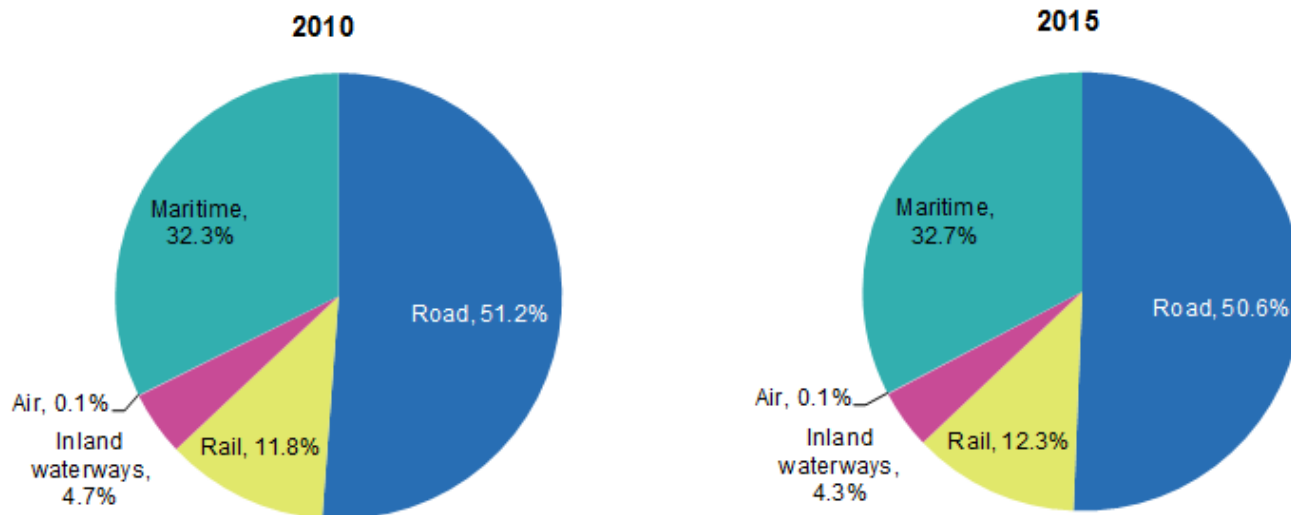

Note: Air and maritime cover only intra-EU transport (transport to/from countries of the EU) and exclude extra-EU transport

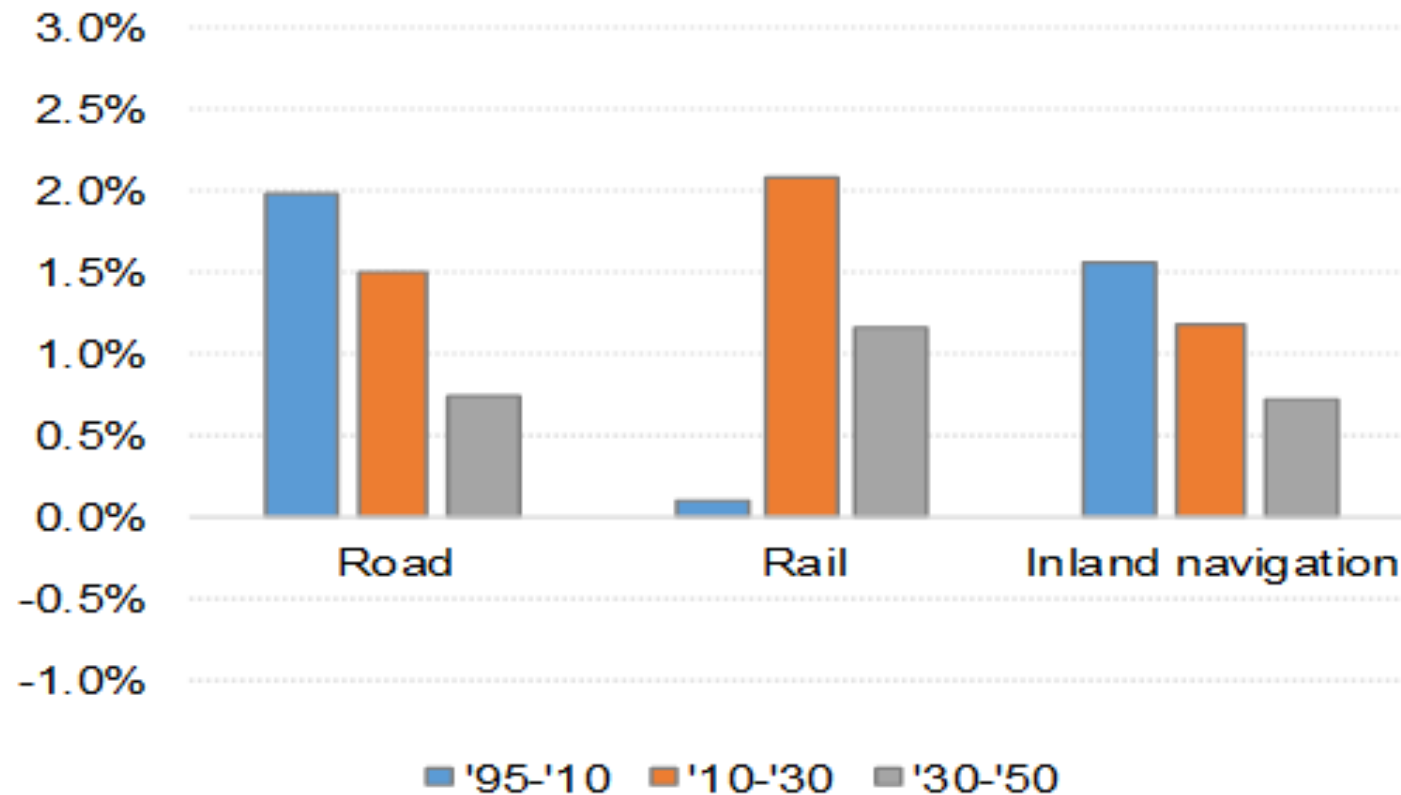

"EU Reference scenario 2016"

- EU transport activity is expected to continue growing under current trends and adopted policies beyond 2015, albeit at a slower pace than in the past.
- Freight transport activity for inland modes is projected to increase by **36% between 2010 and 2030** (1.5% per year) and **60% for 2010-2050** (1.2% per year).
