## Welcome to the ERADIS - European Railway Agency Database of Interoperability and Safety

The ERADIS database shall ensure that the information relevant to the safety and interoperability of the railways in the Member States is accessible and transparent to all interested parties and stakeholders in the railway.

ERADIS shall not be used as operational database, but for information purpose only.



In the Railway Safety Directive 2004/49/EC and the Agency Regulation 881/2004 /with later amendments/, the Agency has been given the task of collecting and providing public access to the following documents:

- The EC declarations of verification of subsystems;
- The EC declarations of conformity of constituents;
- EC declarations of suitability for use of interoperability constituents;
- Authorisations for placing in service of fixed installations;
- The licences issued in accordance with Directive 95/18/EC;
- The safety certificates issued in accordance with Article 10 of the Railway Safety Directive;
- Information on the Entities in Charge of Maintenance: the schema decided in each member state, certification bodies documents, ECM certificates, ECM MoU certificates and maintenance functions certificates;
- The investigation reports sent to the Agency in accordance with Article 24 of the Railway Safety Directive;
- A biennial report on safety performance, based on CSIs, national reports on safety and accidents and its own information.

- The link to national rules database NOTIF-IT.

ERATV is established according to Directive 2008/57/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 June 2008 on the interoperability of the rail system within the Community and Commission Implementing Decision 2011/665/EU of 4 October 2011 on the European register of authorised types of railway vehicles.

The register is hosted and maintained by the European Railway Agency (ERA). It contains data on types of vehicle authorised by the Member States pursuant to Article 26 of Directive 2008/57/EC.

## Notif-IT - database for the notification of national railway safety and technical rules



Article 8 of Directive 2004/49/EC (the Railway Safety Directive) requires Member States to notify to the Commission adopted national safety rules and, under certain conditions (Article 8 (6)), draft safety rules.

Article 17 of Directive 2008/57/EC for interoperability requires national technical rules to be notified as well.

**Notif-IT** (Notifications using Information Technology) application provides the Member States with the means to notify the national safety and technical rules to the Commission, and to make them available to the public in order to improve rule accessibility.

**Notif-IT** also provides the Member States with the means to notify draft safety rules to the Commission for the evaluation in line with Article 8(7) of the Railway Safety Directive. The draft safety rule module of Notif-IT simplifies the public consultation as required by the Railway Safety Directive. The different stakeholders and the public can comment on notified draft safety rules during the 2 months foreseen for public consultation. These comments are taken into account during the evaluation of the notified drafts by the Commission. The system displays the status of the notified rules.

However, there is no legal obligation to provide an official English translation. Please, therefore, note that in all cases the information in the respective national language takes precedence.

**RDD (Reference documents database)** established according to the Commission Decision 2011/155/EU as legal basis

- ❑ RDD is a public database hosted by ERA. It contains national technical rules and acceptable national means of compliance applied in conjunction with the authorisation of railway.
- ❑ RDD also holds the classifications of rules agreed between MSs to facilitate cross acceptance.
- ❑ All rules, acceptable national means of compliance and classifications are associated with parameters.
- ❑ The RDD can send rules and receive status information to/from NOTIF-IT.
- ❑ The RDD includes a tool for edit and viewing National Legal Frameworks for Vehicle Authorization based on Directive 2008/57/EC.
- ❑ The management and publication of the content in RDD is the responsibility of the MSs.

# The European Register of Infrastructure (RINF)

**RINF (European Register of Infrastructure)** established according to Article 49 of Directive (EU) 2016/797

- ❑ It provided for transparency concerning the main features of the European Railway infrastructure. The common technical specifications are set out in a Commission Implementing Decision (Decision 2014/880/EU from 26 November 2014)
- ❑ It introduces a computerised common user interface (CUI) which simplifies queries of infrastructure data. This interface, set up and managed by the Agency, is publically available.
- ❑ The RINF Decision obliges each Member State to nominate an entity (NRE) in charge of setting up and maintaining its register of infrastructure and to notify an implementation plan.
- ❑ A guide on the application of the common specifications for the Register of Infrastructure as well as regular user meetings organized by the Agency help NREs and infrastructure managers involved to implement the Decision.

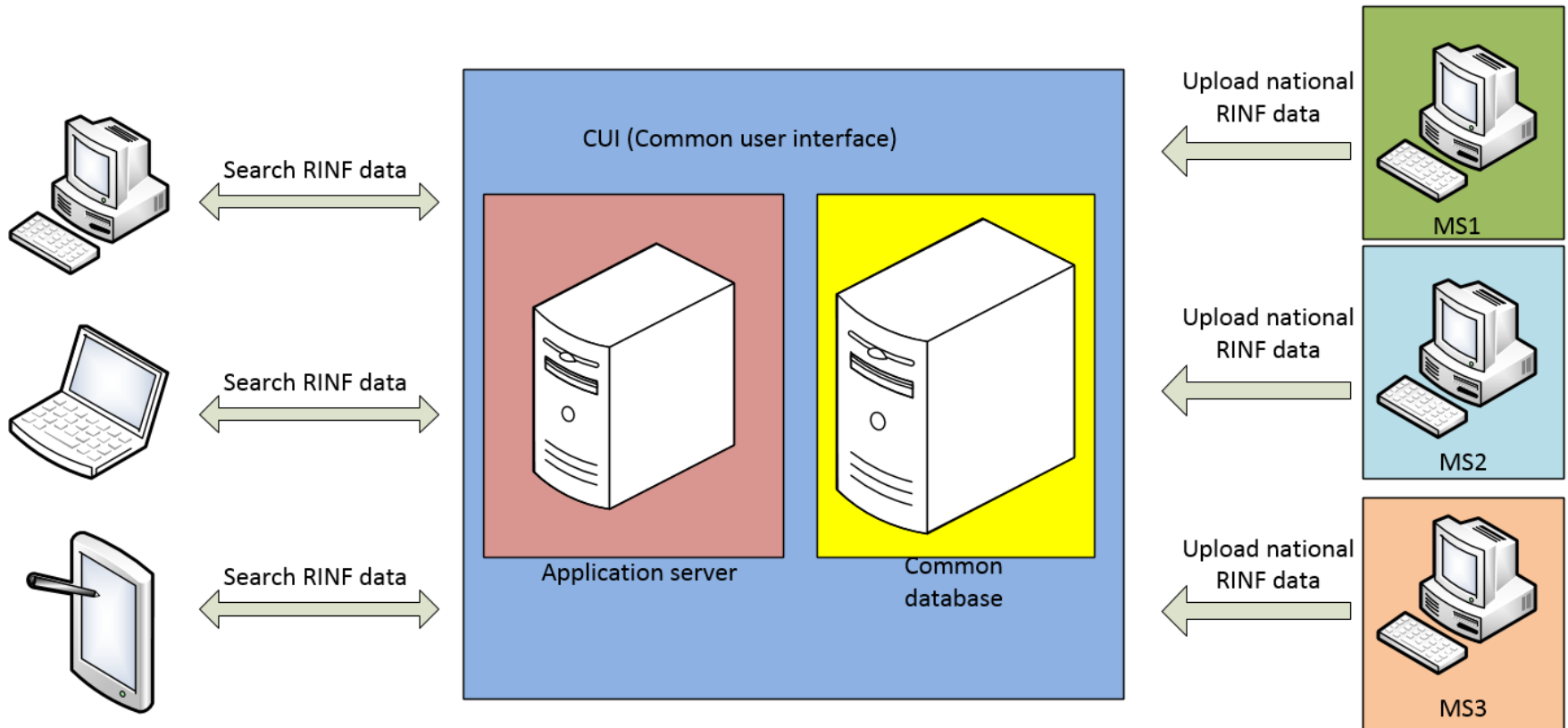

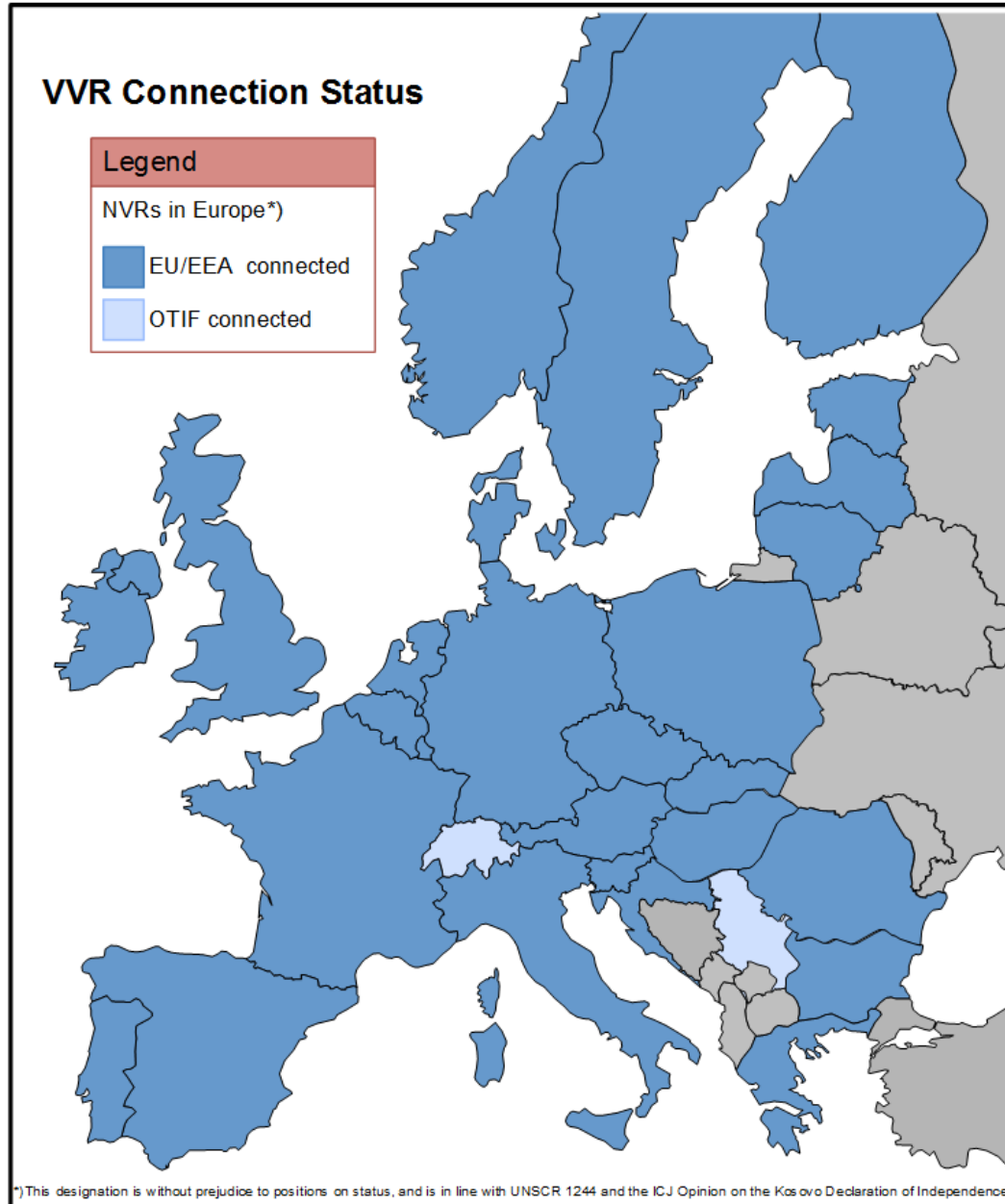

**NVR (National Vehicle Register)** established by Article 33 of Interoperability Directive 2008/57/EC and NVR Decision 2007/756/EC

Register of **all vehicles** in service:

- Kept by each EU Member State (and each non-EU OTIF Contracting State).
- Information on authorization, responsible Keeper, Owner, ECM, reference to the associated type in ERATV.
- Accessible to authorities and to railway actors on the base of predefined access rights.
- Over **1 million** vehicles registered in ECVVR.
- The NVRs and the search engine VVR (Virtual Vehicle Register) in ERA constitute ECVVR (European Centralized Virtual Vehicle Register).
