

How to get to the ERA premises in Lille

From Brussels airport

By train

Take the train from the airport to Brussels Zuid/Midi station. There is a train every 10-20 minutes and the journey takes approximatively 25 minutes. Then take the high-speed train (Thalys or Eurostar) to Lille Europe (France). The journey takes about 35 minutes.

Brussels Airport-Zaventem station is located on level -1.

From Paris airports

1) From Charles de Gaulle Airport

Take the high-speed train (TGV) to Lille Europe station.

2) From Orly Airport

Take the OrlyVal metro to Anthony station. At Anthony station, take RER B to Paris Gare du Nord.

At Paris Gare du Nord, take the high-speed train (TGV) to Lille Europe station. The journey takes about 1h.

From Lille airport

Take the shuttle bus to Lille Flandres station. Walk to our offices opposite the Lille Europe station.
