Then the stakeholder selects which information must be exchanged with the CT customers through the Cesar-Next application.
- train related information such as train arrival forecasts and train ETAs (Estimated Time of Arrival) are also provided as key information to the customers.
- when available, an estimate on the pick-up time (ETP) is also shared on the platform according to the <u>TAF TSI</u> rules.
- Subsidiary Location Codes (SLC) of 500 European Combined Transport Terminals has been synchronized with <u>TAF TSI's Common Reference Data</u> for rail locations.
